Round Pond

875 Rutherford Road, Rutherford

Sit atop their open-air second story lounge with a covered terrace offering panoramic views of the vineyards and the Mayacamas Mountains.

The view from their terrace faces north with a clear vista of the Stags Leap District of the Napa Valley – in particular, the Baldacci Hill.

Artesa

Shafer Vineyards

A must for wine lovers seeking excellence. Known for their famous Chardonnay.

Known for their exquisite Stags Leap Estates Cabernet Sauvignon series, their Pinot Noirs are highly recommended as well.

Paraduxx

7257 Silverado Trail, Napa

From Duckhorn Vineyards, Paraduxx offers amazing red wine blends. A must try is their Postmark from Howell Mountain.

Quintessa

1601 Silverado Trail, St. Helena

Quintessa is a red heritage wine. The vineyard's diversity provides wide stylistic options and each vintage is unique. By appointment only.

Pine Ridge

5901 Silverado Trail, Napa

A Napa Valley winery that produces meticulously hand-crafted Cabernet, Chardonnay, and Bordeaux blend wines.

Domaine Carneros

1240 Duhig Road, Napa

They make three outstanding traditional styles of sparkling wine: Brut, Brut Rosé and Blanc de Blancs. The Le Réve Blanc de Blancs is our favorite. Dog Friendly.
